What the gospel gives us	Discussion questions
GRATITUDE	 What did we learn about Jesus that makes us thankful to him?
	 What opportunities will you have to show your thankfulness this week? How can you remember Jesus at those times?
CONFIDENCE	What did we learn about how God empowers his people, making them able to serve and obey him?
	 What helps from the Spirit shall we use to become better servants of God? (Examples of help from the Spirit are prayer, the Bible, and support from others in the church.)
HOPE	 What did we learn about why following Jesus is exciting and worth it?
	 What sometimes feels better than Jesus? Tell about times when putting him first seems to cost you too much. How can you believe Jesus is better at those times?
COMFORT	 What did we learn that might make you scared you aren't good enough? Be glad you're forgiven in Jesus!
	 Which things do you avoid doing for God because you might fail? How might you be brave because you know God accepts you even when you fail?
